## Challenges



- \* KZN has the second highest number of covid cases
- Our donating hospitals are covid designated hospitals
- Staff movements between wards
- ❖ Lack of access to the hospitals lack of training, visibility and implementation
- No elective surgeries lack of femoral heads being donated
- Doctors and patients delaying procedures
- Unable to reach our targets

## Progress



- We started the program with 4 hospitals, and we now stand at 9
- Next phase will be all Lenmed hospitals, Howick, Nu-Shifa, Ethekewini and La Verna in Ladysmith
- Following that, St Augustine's, The Bay, Life Empangeni, Melomed and Shelly Beach
- Presently we are in negations with the Mediclinic Group

## Victories



- We started this project in mid 2019 with just four hospitals now have a target of 21!
- ❖ Now that we are back to level 1, access to the hospitals for training and implementation is allowed
- We are able to exceed our targets
- Success fully launched the Organ and tissue donor memorial garden
- Increased awareness on social media with Hero 777
- We will continue to grow the femoral head donation program here in KZN
